The Gastrointestinal Unit (GI Unit) is open 5 days a week Monday - Friday. We provide inpatient, outpatient and tertiary services for patients requiring endoscopic procedures. These comprise of diagnostic and complex interventional Gastroscopy, Full/Left Colonoscopy, ERCP, Endoscopic Ultrasound and Percutaneous Endoscopic Gastrostomy (PEG).
