Requirements if ECMO is to be initiated in the referral hospital:

Equipment:

Trolley x2 Surgical Masks with Visors Caps, Sterile gowns and gloves Large sterile surgical drapes Towel clips Sterile gauze squares Betadine solution (non-alcohol based) Heparin: 50 -100 units/kg for systemic anticoagulation 500mls Normal Saline with 500 units Heparin added to flush ECMO cannulae Sterile jug (0.5 or 1L) 50 ml catheter-tipped syringes x2 18G needle x1 10ml syringes x2 5ml syringes x2 Sterile clear occlusive dressing x6

Prior to initiation of ECMO:

Consider ready availability of Red Blood Cells (2 units) Consider placement of Right Radial Arterial Line (for peripheral V-A ECMO) Consider placement of antimicrobial coated CVC (retain Right Internal Jugular and Femoral Vein sites for ECMO Cannulae) Consider placement of Tracheostomy, Naso-Gastric tube, long-term Urinary Catheter Echocardiography and Vascular Ultrasound equipment if available
