Nursing plays an integral role in the following areas of speciality

- Clinical Nurse Specialist in Liaison mental health based onsite in the Mater Misericordiae University Hospital.
- Clinical Nurse Specialist Team in the Emergency Department engaging with people who present to the Emergency Department with self-harm or thoughts of self-harm.
- Mental Health Nurses within the acute inpatient setting providing 24 hour holistic care to residents requiring acute intervention and stabilisation. St. Aloysius Ward is a 15 bed acute inpatient mental health care facility where residents are presenting with a range of disorders such as Depression, Psychotic illness, Affective disorders, Anxiety.
